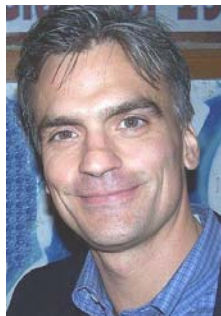
Recognizing and Managing Countertransference in Problem Gambling Clinical Work

February 24, 2011 - March 19, 2012

This advanced-level online course is an intensive study of countertransference and how it impacts clinical judgment and treatment. Participants will engage in online discussions after reading relevant scholarly articles, explore familiar clinical concepts in the context of problem gambling, and engage in interactive clinical case study reviews with the focus on individuals struggling with disordered gambling.
